

Urban Aboriginal Community Request For Proposals (RFP's) Final Results

Closed: July 8, 2011

Successful Proponents:

- \$100,000 Community Futures Development Corporation of Central Interior First Nations (CFDC of CIFN) to deliver two service delivery contracts of "Preparation for Employment Training Programs" for multi-barriered clients dealing with legal issues, as well as linking unemployed trades clients with training opportunities. This training must not duplicate the programs currently offered by the Aboriginal Training Employment Centre (ATEC) Essential Skills Program. In depth assistance will be offered to clients facing legal issue and barriers to employment. CIFN will be working with local legal resource organizations and Canada Corrections to assist clients in overcoming barriers. CITAC will be offering Trades expertise to this program.
- \$50,000 Secwepemc Cultural Education Society (SCES) to deliver Aboriginal Small Business and Construction Careers training. Service delivery is required to focus on an Aboriginal client group that is currently under-serviced. For example: offering training to the large number of people recently mandated off Social Assistance, or employed persons that are under-skilled and require further certifications in order to maintain their employment. Program service delivery must not duplicate programs and services already offered by the Aboriginal Skills Employment Training Services (ASETS) offices, for example ATEC or CITAC.
